Burial Procedures

- Contact All Souls Parish Office for Cemetery interment.
- > Only a duly authorized Roman Catholic Priest or Deacon may officiate at the interment graveside service; the only religious service permitted within the cemetery shall be a Catholic service.
- Burials are not permitted on Sundays, Thanksgiving, Christmas Day, New Year's Day or Good Friday.
- No burial will be permitted without a concrete vault to contain remains.
- Atlas Concrete Products is the only company permitted to open and close a grave.

Headstones or Monuments

- > Permission and approval **must** be obtained prior to placing any headstone or marker on a grave.
- Sizes for each headstone is limited to the following:
 - o Single Grave: 36" wide, including the base; Single Cremation Grave: flush 24"x12" maximum.
 - Two Graves adjacent: 72" wide, including the base.
 - o Note: headstones East of the main entry road **must** be flat or low slope.
- Bases for upright headstones are required.
- > All vases for flowers must be either granite or bronze and permanently attached to headstone or base.

Cemetery Perpetual Care Rules and Regulations

We appreciate your cooperation in abiding by the following rules to facilitate maintenance and retain the dignified appearance of our cemetery:

- Each gravesite will be permitted **ONE** decorative item: a granite or bronze vase for flowers OR one small religious statue (non-plastic); the vase or statue **must** be secured to the headstone or a permanent base.
- Nothing (plants, flowers, shrubs, or trees) can be planted In the ground except by Cemetery staff.
- Solar lights, border edging, and rocks interfere with the mowing and trimming around the headstones and are
 - **not permitted** around any gravesite. Only existing granite borders in the west section are allowed to remain.
- > Breakable articles and containers will be removed by Cemetery staff.
- Dead, wilted, or faded flowers will be removed by Cemetery staff.
- Benches are not permitted at any gravesite as of June 2011.

The Cemetery maintains the right to modify the rules and regulations governing the on-going perpetual care of the cemetery as deemed necessary.
